



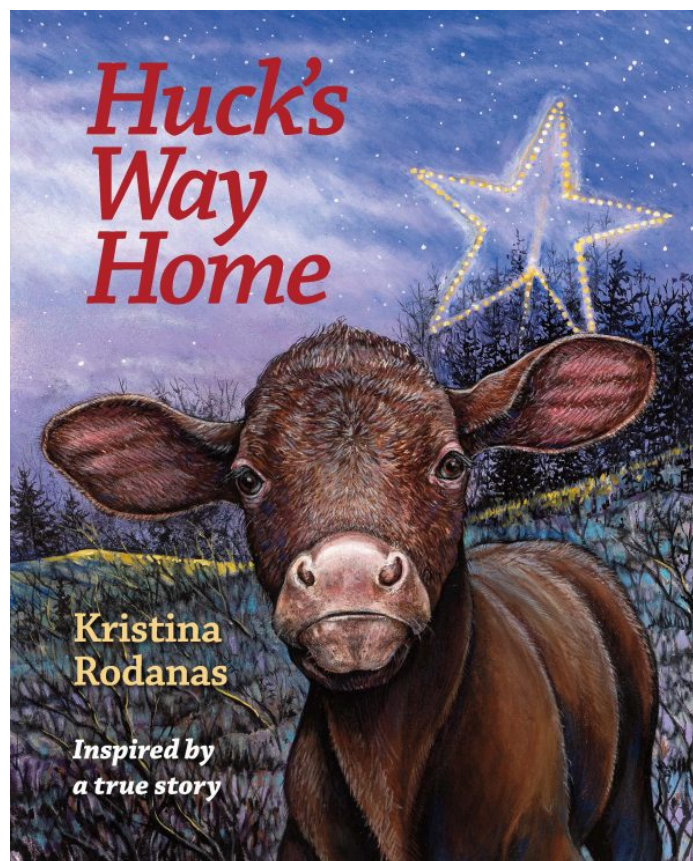

HUCK EARS

You may have heard of Huck—a mischievous calf who escaped Billings Farm & Museum on his first day at his new home. The story of his adventure is told in the children's book *Huck's Way Home*. Huck still lives at Billings Farm, although he is much bigger these days!

Follow these instructions to make a set of Huck ears and head out for an adventure of your own!



CRAFT: HUCK EARS

Materials:

- Huck ear templates (see last page of these instructions)
- Paper (brown or white)
- Scissors
- Colored pencils, crayons, or markers
- A glue stick or stapler



Steps:

1. Cut out the Huck ear templates from the last page of these instructions.
2. Trace the Huck ear templates onto paper.
3. Cut out the ears.
4. Cut a strip of paper for the headband and measure it to fit around your head with a little extra length.
5. Color the ears however you would like.
6. Glue or staple the headband shut.
7. Attach the ears to the headband with glue or staples.
8. Show off your Huck Ears!
