FLUFFIEST

FAMOUS FOR THE SIZE OF THEIR FLEECES

Unlike most other animals, sheep are not able to shed their dense wool. This means that they need to be sheared (get a haircut) about once a year. These sheep put off their appointments for a little longer than they should have!



Name: SHREK THE SHEEP

Location: **NEW ZEALAND**

Year: 2004

Shrek the Sheep, a merino, had spent six years living in caves when he was found. He became a national celebrity, and even met the Prime Minister! His 60-pound fleece held the world record for eleven years.





Name: CHRIS

Location: AUSTRALIA

Year: **2015**

Chris, also a merino, now holds the world record for "Most Wool Sheared from a Sheep – Single Shearing", at 90 pounds! He hadn't been sheared in five years and his fleece weighed more than 8 times the average for his breed (11 lb.).

FAMOUS FOR HER LONG LIFE

Sheep usually live for an average of 10-12 years, depending on their breed. This lady beat them all!

Name: **METHUSELINA**

Location: SCOTLAND

Year: **2012**

Methuselina, a Scottish blackface, lived to the ripe old age of 25 years and 11 months. That's more than twice the average!



HIGHEST IN THE AIR

FAMOUS FOR TAKING FLIGHT

Sheep mostly like to keep their feet on the ground. But thanks to the Montgolfier brothers and the early tests of their hot air balloon, this sheep took to the skies.

Name: MONTAUCIEL

Location: FRANCE

Year: 1783

Montauciel (meaning Climb-to-the-Sky) was accompanied by a duck and a rooster as they flew 1,500 feet above Paris.



MOST AMBITIOUS

FAMOUS FOR HIS MILITARY CAREER

The Mercian Regiment of the British Army has had a sheep as a mascot for over 100 years. All have remained at the rank of private, until this guy.

Name: LANCE CORPORAL DERBY XXX

Location: UNITED KINGDOM

Year: 2015

Though his duties were mostly ceremonial, Lance Corporal Derby, a Swaledale ram, was promoted for "good behavior."



MOST SCIENTIFIC

FAMOUS FOR HER ASSISTANCE IN SCIENTIFIC ADVANCEMENT

Few sheep have had as great an impact on world of science as this one. She is truly famous the world over.

Name: **DOLLY**

Location: SCOTLAND

Year: **1996**

Dolly was one of the first mammals ever to be cloned, and the first ever to be cloned from an adult cell. She took the media by storm and sparked many discussions about the pros and cons of cloning.
