DRAFT ANIMAL CELEBRATION: MAKE YOUR OWN HOBBYHORSE!

Materials:

- Brown tissue paper or streamer paper
- Glue stick
- Scissors
- Hot glue gun
- Markers
- Brown paper bag
- Wooden dowel (or cardboard wrapping paper tube)



Steps:

1. Cut the brown paper bag so it is one large, flat piece of paper.
2. Print the hobby horse template and cut it out. Then trace it onto the brown paper bag and cut that out. You will need two cut-outs to glue together later. Cut out two ear templates as well.
3. Glue a 3-inch-wide piece of tissue paper or streamer paper down the back of the horse's head on the inside of your cut-out. Glue another 3-inch-wide piece to the top of the horse's head. Add three layers of tissue paper to each place. This is the horse's mane.
4. Using a glue stick, glue around the horse's head on the inside side and line it up with the other cut-out. DO NOT glue to bottom of the horse neck, you'll need to put the dowel there later.
5. Cut small strips into the tissue paper for the mane.
6. Draw on a bridle, eyes, and mouth to each side of the horse's head. Using a glue stick, glue on the two horse ears to the top of the head.
7. Open the bottom of the horse's neck and hot glue the dowel inside.
