HISTORY

Frederick Billings (1823-1890), born in Royalton, Vermont, purchased the 250-acre Marsh Farm from Charles Marsh in 1869. Billings attended the University of Vermont, studied law, and eventually traveled to California during the gold rush, where he made his fortune as a lawyer, land developer, and railroad tycoon. He became wealthy and traveled widely but considered Woodstock, Vermont, his home. In 1862, Frederick met and married Julia Parmly (1835-1914). Born and raised in New York City, Julia was the daughter of prominent New York dentist Dr. Eleazar Parmly and Anna Maria Valk Smith Parmly. Julia was educated at several private day academies in New York and traveled extensively. Frederick and Julia would raise seven children in Woodstock.

Frederick Billings' approach to farm management embraced modern scientific principles, and he considered his success an example for neighboring farmers and others in the local area and the state. He operated a diversified farm with crops and livestock. He embarked on a careful plan of scientific forestry to restore the woods on his property that had suffered from years of neglect and over-cutting. His first farm manager, George Weston, concentrated on improving dairy production by importing Jersey cattle, which produce milk with a high butterfat content. The farm established a prized herd of Jersey cattle by importing Jerseys and careful breeding. In 1884, Billings hired Scotsman George Aitken, who worked and managed the farm profitably for the next twenty-six years. Aitken introduced Southdown sheep and Berkshire swine and oversaw the construction of several barns. He supervised up to one hundred farm workers in 1890. Under Aitken's management, Billings Farm achieved national prominence with the top honors awarded to the Jersey herd at the World's Columbian Exposition in Chicago in 1893.

After Frederick Billings's death in 1890, Julia and Frederick's oldest child, Laura Billings (1864-1938), assumed general management and supervision of the Estate grounds, Farm, and forest. She studied forestry and set up an office at the Farm to meet often with Farm Manager George Aitken. With assistance from Aitken and Estate trustees Samuel Kilner and Franklin Noble Billings, Laura added hundreds of acres to the Estate's holdings and reforested several areas on Mt. Tom. After Laura's marriage in 1910, the Estate responsibilities fell to Laura's siblings. When Julia Parmly Billings died in 1914, the Estate was divided, and Richard Billings inherited the Farm. By 1917 Billings Farm was losing money, and Richard sold the farmland to his sisters Mary Montagu Billings French (1869-1951) and Elizabeth Billings (1871-1944). Mary and Elizabeth instructed the new farm manager, Arthur Snyder, hired in 1917, to reduce operations and limit extensive farming. This approach would keep the Farm going in an era of agricultural decline in Vermont.

In 1933, the sisters purchased the adjoining Windsor County Fairgrounds, which Frederick Billings had unsuccessfully attempted years before. However, in the mid-1930s, amid the

economic turmoil of the Great Depression, the Billings once again reduced farm operations, and in 1936, they sold the Jersey herd to a neighboring farm in South Woodstock. Billings Farm continued to produce hay and crops.

After twenty-six years of management, Arthur Snyder retired in 1943. Elizabeth Billings and Mary French hired Harold Corkum as farm manager and began to rebuild the farm as a commercial dairy. Billings Farm resurrected the dairy operation and restocked the Farm's Jersey herd. They expanded the dairy's bottling capacity, purchased a fleet of delivery trucks, and expanded and modernized the lower barns.

In September of 1944, Elizabeth Billings passed away and left her share of the farm and other property to be used by her sister Mary until her death; it was then bequeathed to Mary French's three children. At Mary's death in 1951, her three children, John French, Jr. (1909-1984), Mary French Rockefeller (1910-1997), and Elizabeth French Hitchcock (1912-1976), inherited the 782-acre estate.

Frederick Billings' granddaughter, Mary French Rockefeller, and her husband, Laurance S. Rockefeller (1910-2004), purchased the farmlands from the heirs and continued the property's agricultural legacy. The Rockefellers merged the Billings Farm with the Billings Farm & Museum, which opened in 1983 as an operating dairy farm and history museum that interprets Vermont's rural, cultural, and agrarian heritage.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

Description:

This collection documents farm operations and related activities from the establishment of Billings Farm by Frederick Billings in 1871 through June 1993, when Laurance Rockefeller merged Billings Farm and Billings Farm & Museum and transferred oversight to The Woodstock Foundation, Inc. In addition to documents relating to operations at Billings Farm, the collection includes material relating to the Billings Estate, today Marsh-Billings-Rockefeller National Historical Park. It includes the receipts from two Mansion renovations, 1885-1886 and 1950-1960; the Mansion housekeeper's grocery accounts and other domestic papers of the Billings family are interfiled with the farm business. The entire estate was operated as a single enterprise until the mid-1970s and is reflected in surviving records.

The collection comprises 112.5 linear feet of manuscripts and 13.5 linear feet of images. Manuscripts are stored in folders and housed in archival document boxes and cartons. Photographs are stored in archival document boxes, cartons, and portfolio boxes; oversized photographs, maps, and architectural plans are stored flat in map case drawers.

Provenance:

Farm employees and Billings' family members acting as stockholders and managers created the material comprising the Billings Farm Records. The records were retained from several farm offices, buildings, and barns on the Billings Estate and collected from the Billings family

and their descendants, descendants of former employees, and outside sources. The collection documents the history and operation of Billings Farm from its establishment by Frederick Billings in 1871 through 1993, when Laurance Rockefeller merged Billings Farm with the Billings Farm & Museum and transferred oversight to the Woodstock Foundation.

Custodial history:

The Billings Farm Records were first assembled in the 1970s. At that time, the collection was maintained as a private collection owned by Mary French Rockefeller, Frederick Billings' granddaughter, and her husband, Laurance S. Rockefeller. The material was retained from Billings Farm offices and other buildings and barns on the former Billings Estate and collected from outside sources to document the history and operations of the farm, agricultural practices, farm equipment, and capital improvements to the farmlands and buildings.

The material was collected from various sources. In 1977, the Vermont Folklife Project staff inventoried the collection of books and papers housed in the Farm Manager's House attic and moved the material to the attic at the Rockefeller residence, today the Mansion at Marsh-Billings-Rockefeller NHP. In 1986, most of the collection was moved to the Richard Billings House. Some items from the inventory remained in storage on the Mansion property after 1986. The collection was enlarged by adding selected books and pamphlets from the Mansion Library. In 1993, Billings Farm & Museum staff moved additional archival material stored in the Farm Manager's office and the hayloft over the calf barn to the Richard Billings House. This material was produced during the Harold Corkum and Fred Nilges management eras between 1943 and 1974 and during Robert Lord's tenure, 1974-1992. During an archival survey in 2013, the Corkum, Nilges, and Lord records were in a closet on the first floor of the Richard Billings house and found in labeled archival quality containers (20+ years old) and in fair-good condition.

Also found with the Corkum, Nilges, and Lord records were four record boxes of Rockefeller papers sent to the Woodstock Foundation between 2005 and 2008. Three boxes were labeled *MFR Dead Files*, and one was labeled *LSR Reserve Files*. This material consists of Billings family-related items, including 19th and 20th-century books; several are inscribed and contain inserted notes and letters to various family members. The Rockefeller boxes also contained Julia Parmly Billings Prayer book, c.1906; photographs; appraisals and inventories; clippings and journals; two scrapbooks; three architectural drawings of the Mansion, and oral history cassette tapes and VHS videotapes relating to the Billings and Rockefeller families, the Woodstock Estate, and the Billings Farm & Museum. The papers were left as found, alphabetically by subject, and may have been arranged by the Rockefellers themselves or a Rockefeller employee. Because the contents are mostly family-related, the records were transferred to the *Billings Family Papers*, recorded as an accrual, rehoused, and relabeled as the *Rockefeller Estate Papers*. The Billings Farm Records collection has been cited in the past as the Billings Farm & Museum Archives, Billings Farm Archives, and the Billings Property Archives.

Accruals:

Accession 2017.001

Jersey Herd Photographs. Nineteen albumen photographs mounted on heavy cardstock. They were returned to BF&M by the Norman Williams Library in 2017.

Accession 2018.001

Nancy Aitken Holt Wiggins Donation. In 2018, Nancy Wiggins, George Aitken's great-granddaughter, donated items given to her grandmother Marion Aitken on her wedding day. The gift includes an eight-piece silver tea service, Marion's prayer book from her wedding, and a photograph of Marion on her wedding day. In the photograph, Marion is shown in her white wedding gown and veil, holding her prayer book in her left hand. The book is signed by several members of the Billings family who attended Marion's wedding on September 23, 1911. Also included are two booklets owned by George Aitken. The tea set (2018.001.0001-2018.001.007 and 2018.001.0012) is cataloged in the permanent artifact collection, and the prayer book, photograph, and booklets (2018.001.0008- 2018.001.0011) were added to the Billings Farm Records.

Accession 2022.001

Various photographs, letters, and Woodstock Inn and Country Club items related to the Billings family and farm were donated by descendants of Franklin Noble Billings.

Accession 2023.001

This gift includes items relating to the Windsor County Fair. Many items are signed by Franklin S. Billings, Nancy Billings, and W. S. French. Descendants of Franklin Noble Billings donated the items.

The *Billings Family Papers* are the personal papers of three generations of the Billings family. The collection's Finding Aid was last updated in 2024.

The Billings Farm & Museum / Woodstock Foundation has unprocessed institutional records.

SERIES DESCRIPTIONS

I. Financial Records (1880-1991)

The financial records consist of account books, expenditure summaries, housekeeper's accounts, invoices, and receipts; budgets and operating expenses; financial statements, check stubs, loose checks, and checkbooks; insurance policies; and payroll records. They were collected and filed over the years by each incumbent farm manager. The early fiscal records, kept by Franklin Noble Billings and others through 1899, were arranged chronologically and recorded as the F.N. Billings records; they were left in this arrangement. Invoices and receipts after 1899 are left in their original order and arranged alphabetically by company name and chronologically within each company. The early financial records relate to the management of the farm and the Billings Estate.

II. Correspondence (1820-1992)

This series contains Billings Farm business-related correspondence regarding farm and estate activities. Letters include those from family members acting as stockholders and managers and correspondence to and from various Farm Managers. Of note are copies of George Aitken's outgoing letters to Billings family members and business associates. The letters are arranged chronologically.

III. Diaries, Notebooks, and Guestbooks (1870-1981)

This series includes two Billings Jersey Herd catalogs, guestbooks, a genealogy, and a prayer book. The *Memorandum of the Events on the Billings Farm* (also referred to as the Farm Memo Diary), 1870-1944, contains recorded activities on the farm and estate, including lands purchased, building improvements, herd information, crops and trees planted on the estate, weather, and precipitation.

IV. Deeds and Legal Papers (1904-1989)

This series includes Billings estate and farm deeds, corporate papers, shareholder papers, and meeting documents. Miscellaneous stock certificates and property rental agreements are also included. They are arranged alphabetically by subject and chronologically within subject.

V. Herd Records (1890-1992)

The herd records consist of award, performance, and registration certificates, pedigree charts, record books, producer records, inventories, and sales. They are arranged alphabetically by type and then chronologically.

VI. Agricultural Records (1935-1975)

This series holds records related to forestry, estate roads, and crops. The papers consist of reports relating to crop plans, soil conservation, and include a Woodland Management Plan. Also included is a Forest Type Map and the Billings Tree Farm Certificate. This series consists of eighteen folders arranged alphabetically by report title.

VII. Personnel Records (1917-1984)

The personnel records series contains employee records and forms, accident reports, and payroll and tax records. In addition, John McDill's 1979-1984 research relating to Billings Farm employees who worked at the farm and estate between 1881-1899 is in this series. The records are arranged alphabetically by subject and chronologically within the subject.

VIII. Printed Material (1821-1989)

The printed material series includes artwork, advertisements, promotional material, calendars, newsletters, product containers and labels, catalogs, and equipment manuals. The series also includes a collection of journals and periodicals collected by the family and farm managers relating to forestry, farming, and agriculture. Additional journals were purchased by staff and added to the collection between 1997 and 2007. When known, they are identified in the container list. Artwork includes seven lithographs of Billings Farm Jerseys that previously hung in the Farm Manager's Office and product design drawings for ice cream containers, milk cartons, and various labels. Also in this series are journals collected by the Billings Family and others associated with the World's Columbian Exposition in Chicago in 1893. The Printed Material series is arranged by subject.

IX. Photographs (1862-1993)

Photographs of the Billings Farm, farm workers, and the Billings family, dating from the mid-19th through the 20th century, visually describe agriculture and farm life in Woodstock, the Upper Connecticut River Valley, and Vermont. Photographs include 19th-century landscape views, farm buildings, livestock, and various activities and events, including fairs, auctions, dairy operations, and prints that document repairs

and renovations to the barns and buildings throughout the years. They are arranged by subject.

X. Maps, Architectural Plans, and Oversize Material (1892-c.1980)

This series includes maps of Vermont, Sanborn Fire Maps of Woodstock Village, and a topographical map of Mt. Tom showing the Pogue. Architectural plans include areas of the Mt. Tom Ski Area, Starlake Dairy, an exterior and two interior floor plans of the farm manager's house on Old River Road, identified as a "Residence on Billings Farm", and a revised floor plan of the cow barn from 1948. Oversize materials include Billings Estate signs, sketches of the Phippen Property, also known as Fogg Farm, and a drawing of Vermont and one of the Taftsville Bridge.
