\$19 per person for groups of 15 or more with advance reservations.

- Access to all museum exhibits.
- Participation in any scheduled non-fee programs.
- Visit our Jersey cows, draft horses, sheep, goats, and chickens.
- Exploration of our 1890 Farmhouse.

Reservation Requirements

Advance Notice: Please schedule your group visit at least **14 days** before arrival.

Blackout dates: 10/3 & 4, 10/10 & 11

Confirmation & Payment: Due **48 hours** before your visit. When your group leader calls or emails to confirm the number of guests, they will be expected to pay for the visit.

- Your group will be charged for the confirmed number of guests.
- More guests beyond your confirmed count? Please have payment ready upon arrival.

Motorcoach Arrival Procedures

Billings Farm & Museum Visitor Center is located at 23 Elm Street, Woodstock, VT. It is a RIGHT turn into the Visitor Center parking lot. Please have the driver pull up in front of the Visitor Center.

Running late OR early? We want (and need) to know! Please NO early bird arrivals! We open at 10AM – plan accordingly!

Upon Arrival:

- Please keep your group on the bus until you are greeted by a member of our staff.
- Our team will provide an overview of the site and any pertinent site information.

For Drivers:

- Bus parking area is across from the Visitor Center in our auxiliary lot.
- **NO IDLING** permitted at Visitor Center or bus parking lot – this is Vermont law!
- We appreciate your cooperation in keeping our farm air quality pristine.

Having lunch delivered? We can reserve picnic tables for you!

Capacity: Up to 50 guests at our picnic tables. In the event of inclement weather, we will provide a dry space for your guests.

Reservation Fee: \$85/hour (minimum 1-hour increments)

- Includes setup and breakdown time.
- One complimentary trash bag is provided.
- Additional trash bags: \$15 each
- Groups larger than 50? Contact us for custom arrangements.

Please Note: Groups planning to eat on-site must reserve space in advance. Tables cannot be guaranteed without reservations. Please let us know you will be having lunch delivered so we can plan to meet the delivery!
